ENGINE

Engine Coolant Windshield Washer Fluid All Hoses are Clamped

SAFETY CHECKS

Make sure to always conduct your safety check in a counterclockwise direction, starting at the passenger entry door. That will ensure the driver will be facing any possible oncoming traffic at all times.

EXTERIOR CHECKLIST:

Starting at the Passenger entry door, make sure entry door is closed all the way, and if applicable, make sure electric entry steps are completely retracted.

Check the curb side front tire for inflation, condition of the tire, and depth of tread (> 4/32")

Check that the curb side compartment doors are latched and locked

Check the windshield for cleanliness and condition

Check the windshield wiper arms and wiper blades

Check the road side front tire for inflation, condition of the tire, and depth of tread (> 4/32")

Check that all roadside lower compartments are completely shut, latched, and locked

Check that the generator and battery compartment doors are shut, latched, and locked.

Check the road side rear tires for inflation, condition of the tires, and depth of tread (> 2/32")

Check the curb side rear tires for inflation, condition of the tires, and depth of tread (> 2/32")

Make sure that the leveling jacks are all completely retracted, awnings are folded in, and slide outs are in and properly secured. (If applicable)

Make sure that Shore Power and any other battery charging cords are disconnected and stored away properly.

INTERIOR CHECKLIST:

Starting at the rear of the clinic, move forward making sure all equipment and devices are secured for travel.

If your unit has slide outs, awning systems, or jacks make sure all are completely in and locked. Double check by hitting the interior switches

Make sure all cabinets and drawers are closed and locked for travel.

Check that all seatbelts are securely fastened and functioning

Make any final mirror and camera adjustments from the driver's seat for optimal road views.

After starting the engine, check oil pressure and fuel levels.

Test windshield wipers and fluid for operation

Check that Heat/AC works

Before moving the vehicle, check for any traffic or hazards that may be in your pathway
